

HISTORY



WHY LEARN?

Researchers Karel Lewit MD and Sarka Olsanska in their published paper entitled:



concluded that...

"The treatment of active scars can be of importance in a great number of cases; untreated, active scars are an important cause of therapeutic failure. Treatment also widens the scope of manipulative therapy."

This research gives us a glimpse into an area that is largely ignored in the education program that many bodyworkers undertake - that of scar tissue treatment. In fact that is precisely why Alastair McLoughlin designed this work. He knew that scars exerted an inhibitory effect upon the bio-mechanics of the human frame.

This is largely due to the way the fascia is distorted and restricted because of the formation of scar tissue. The densely packed collage creates a 'fracture' in the seamless fabric of the skin and compromises the elasticity of the skin and underlying tissue membranes.

When we understand the interconnectedness of the human body the treatment of all scar tissue becomes *essential* to the therapeutic outcome. No longer can we ignore the effect that scar tissue exerts in both the physical but also energetic pathways.

ENERGY PATHWAYS

For thousands of years the underpinning teachings of Traditional Chinese Medicine (TCM) has focussed upon the energy pathways that deliver Qi (Chi) throughout the body systems using a network called Meridians.

It cannot be too difficult to contemplate that, just like nerves and blood vessels that get severed during surgery or trauma, these pathways also get interrupted.

Patients often feel a “re-connection” of their own body as MSTR® work is carefully applied. This can be quite common with Caesarean section scars and trauma wound scars for example.

A scar is a visible reminder of the event that created it and some reactions to these events could even be categorised as Post Traumatic Stress Disorder.

Isn't that a good enough reason alone to want to learn this amazing work?



EVIDENCE-BASED COURSE MATERIAL

We are serious about our work and are delighted to announce the results on the preliminary study into the effects of McLoughlin Scar Tissue Release® (MSTR®) on Caesarean Section scars.

The research project was conducted at The Newcastle Clinic, Newcastle, UK on June 15th, 2019 with Consultant Radiologist Dr Peddada Raju.

A General Electric (GE) Soniq S8 ultrasound scanner was used for the test.

Three test subjects with C-sections were pre-scanned and images recorded. Size and depth of scar tissue was also recorded and the amount of vascularity both surrounding and within the scar was also imaged.



MSTR® work was then applied for a total of 15 minutes per subject only, as a single treatment.

Immediately afterwards a post-treatment ultrasound scan was then conducted by Dr Raju.

All three subjects were shown to have decreased scar tissue in the post treatment scan. One example of improvement was of a scar that was measured at 31.5mm pre treatment. The scar was re-measured at just 18.1mm post treatment.

Another example was that of a longitudinal scar reducing in size from 22.7mm pre-treatment to just 10.4mm post-treatment.

An increase in vascularity was noted not only in the surrounding tissue but also actually *through* the scar. Interestingly no vascularity was present in the pre-scan of the same area.

This confirms what has always been taught: MSTR® helps open the densely bound collagen fibres that make up scar tissue to allow increased blood flow into the area once again.

This preliminary success has now kick-started a larger study that will be undertaken at 'The Newcastle' later in 2019.
